Lunch Ordering

If your child will be late to school due to an appointment etc, please contact the Office by 9am to order a lunch, if it is required.

Starting Reception Class in 2019

If you have a child who will be 5 between 1 Sept 2019 and 31 Aug 2020, you must apply for a school place **before** January 15th 2019. You can apply online @ www.admissionsonline.norfolk.gov.uk.

Reminders

If your child is sick, they **MUST** stay home for 48hrs after the last bout of sickness; do not send them to school before this.

If your child is not going to be in school, for whatever reason, you **MUST** contact the school by 9am to let us know why, even if they will be in later that day.

PE kits, should be brought to school on a Monday and taken home on a Friday to be washed.

Please read Class Dojo regularly, as this is the teacher's way of communicating information to parents.

Please read the Newsletter each Wednesday, as it is a running list of all events that are coming up in school. If you see an event on here which may include your child, and you have not received information about it, ask the class teacher, or at the Office. The Office staff spends so much unnecessary time chasing permission slips, which does not help in the organization of trips etc. The kitchen needs to know well in advance of packed lunches needed for outings, and money often needs to be paid before a trip takes place, so returning slips/contributions on the day of the trip is really not helpful at all.

The Newsletter is emailed to parents every Wednesday. There are paper copies available in the Reception area of the Office and it is also on the Bluebell Primary school website, so 3 places you can check, to keep up to date with what is happening in school.

On Wednesday 5 December (morning) the Office staff will be out on training, so only urgent enquiries can be dealt with.
