



Pupils will learn

Children will learn about people in our communities that help us and the jobs they do.

Overview

Week 1: People who help us.
Talking about all the different jobs people do.

Week 2: Dentist.
Why is it important to look after our teeth and how to brush them. Visit from the dentist.

Week 3: Doctors.
What do doctors do for us? Why do we go to the doctors and what happens when we are there. Being safe with medicine.

Week 4: Police.
How police in our community help us. Visit from police to talk about uniform and thinking about different police vehicles.

Week 5: Fireman.
Talk about fire safety. Learn the emergency number. Talk about their special uniform and features of a fire engine. Visit from Fireman and engine.

Week 6: Heroes.
Talk about make believe heroes and what is special about them. Super hero celebration day.

Home Learning Ideas

- Looking at pictures and naming parts of the different uniforms.
- Learn emergency numbers.
- Sharing non-fiction books.
- Learning how to brush your teeth.

Other ideas

- Spotting and identifying emergency vehicles.
- Share books in the library
- Talk about who helps you in your family.
- Who is our hero?

Books to share at home

- Fireman Sam, Paw Patrol - any superhero books
- Factual books about emergency services.
- Peppa Pig and the Tooth Fairy.
- Supertato books.
- Superworm.

- Find out how long you should brush your teeth for?
- What do you go to the doctors for?
- Who helps us to look after our teeth?
- What does a Firefighter use to put out a fire?
