Safeguarding at school

Ofsted are currently in the process of checking that **all** schools are safeguarding their pupils well enough. We wanted to tell you that we have four adults in school who children and families can talk to if they or their families are at risk of serious harm. **Mrs Plowman, Mr Dooley, Miss Eastick and Mrs Honeyman all have training and experience** in supporting families where there are problems such as domestic violence, drugs or alcohol problems, or other forms of harm. They work with Children's Services, or the police to help keep children and families safe. Also, they have the job of checking that all adults in school are safe and know how to investigate any complaints about this.
